



# HELPMANN ACADEMY INREVIEW MENTORSHIP

**Do you have ambitions to be an arts reviewer, but don't know where to begin? Applications for the Helpmann Academy *InReview* Mentorship are now open.**

The Helpmann Academy *InReview* Mentorship seeks to develop the next generation of arts reviewers and re-build the practice of robust discourse and analysis of South Australian performing and visual arts.

The mentoring program, a partnership between Helpmann Academy and Solstice Media, will connect experienced arts writers with emerging voices, as part of a project to strengthen coverage of arts and culture in South Australia. This collaboration is part of *InReview*, a new sub-site of InDaily which will publish credible arts journalism and cultural commentary each week.

The successful mentee will be matched with an *InReview* mentor who will work with them in all aspects of writing reviews as well as providing career advice. The mentorship will be conducted over eight hours per week for 10 weeks. Throughout

the program, the mentee will build their skills with the aim to produce a number of written reviews for publication on *InReview*.

The Helpmann Academy *InReview* Mentorship recipient will be engaged from July 2021 (dates TBC) for 10 weeks. The recipient will receive a fee of \$2,500.

This role provides a unique opportunity for an emerging creative to gain hands-on experience in building up content for a site that promises to be a new model for arts journalism throughout Australia.

This significant opportunity allows the successful applicant to strengthen their creative practice with arts writing experience.
