As mentee, the selected curator will be engaged to work on the exhibition from selections, designing the layout, working with artists, and installation and de-installation.

The Project Curator will be engaged from December 2020 – February 2021. Remuneration for the role is \$1,500.

This role provides a unique opportunity for an emerging curator to gain hands-on experience working on a high-profile exhibition that brings together graduating artists working in many mediums. The Project Curator will be empowered to develop and broaden their understanding of how to
